Pads light up with the slightest touch. Provides both visual and tactile experiences. Multicolored stars move when you press the pad. Soft and squishy pads light up when you touch them



#835 - Lighted Mirror

When you pick up the mirror the lights turn on. This encourages the child to visually attend to him/herself and increases bi-lateral hand usage.





#1784 - Mini Dome




#2213 - Topsy Turvy

SW #1 - Blocks with Velcro

Move blocks from the Velcro strip into nearby container. By design, the student is encouraged to take one block at a time.

SW #2 - Blocks with Containers

Move blocks from open container to lidded container. The lid with the cross slit requires the student to apply greater pressure to be successful.

SW #3 - Wooden Nickels

Move wood nickels from upright positions and place into lidded container.

SW #4 - Pegs

Move pegs from upright positions and place into lidded container. The smaller opening requires greater focus to be successful.

SW #5 - Clothespins

Move clothespins from the edge of the lid and place through the small opening. Seeing the clothespins disappear into the opening can be a great motivator.

SW #6 - Beads with Pipe Cleaner

Take beads off pipe cleaner and place into opening. Finger dexterity and the coordinated use of two hands are encouraged by design.













SW #7 - Dowels

Move dowels from container and place into small nearby openings. One-to-one correspondence requires greater focus.

SW #8 - Pegs and Vials

Move pegs from container and place into nearby vials; one-to-one correspondence.

SW #9 - Spools

Pull paired spools apart and put into nearby opening.

SW #10 - Locktagons

Pull paired Locktagons apart and put into nearby opening.

SW #11 - Clothespins with Cards

Separate clothespins from plastic cards and place into appropriate openings; a self-correcting activity.

SW #12 - Stack It

Stack Blox upon the one that is preset by teacher onto the shoebox lid.





SW #13 - Cups

Stack cups upon one that is preset by teacher onto the shoebox lid.

SW #14 - Beads with Dowel

Take beads from open container and stack onto upright dowel.



SW #15 - Stacking Pegs

Take pegs from open container and stack onto those preset by teacher on the shoebox lid; a simple stack or up to a three-way, color sort and stack.



SW #16 - Sorting

Take wood nickels and balls from open container and sort into one of two nearby containers, matching each object. With success, two additional objects can be added.













SW #17 - Red Buttons into Water

An all-time favorite, the action of the buttons in the water has captivated many individuals. A proven motivator and door-opener to learning.

SW #18 - Bead Stack 1-5

A one-unit stacking task that visually demonstrates the concept of counting from one to five.

SW #19 - Dox Blox

The individual matches a given order of colored blox, assembles the pieces, and puts them in the finished area.

SW #20 - Letter, Shape, Number, Color Match

This one-unit matching task encourages independence while practicing academic readiness skills

SW #21 - Bead Slide

An opportunity for the student to cross the midline and slide beads into the finished opening.

SW #22 - Lacing

The student laces through a series of eyebolts following a designated path that ends at the red (finished) opening.













SW #23 - Match, Assemble, and Packaging

A multi-step activity: matching objects to pictures, assembly and packaging.

SW #24 - Pipettes

Through the action of squeezing and drawing colored water into the transparent pipette, students fill containers affixed to the lid or create works of art using an absorbent napkin.

SW #25 - Flex Tube

Visual and auditory effects created by dropping a ball into a transparent, flexible tube motivate students to complete the activity

SW #26 - Color Match Sequence

Nine different colored coins are used in groups of three for matching or sequencing patterns.

SW #27 - Drum Roll

Watching one of the ten balls funneling its way down into the opening becomes a captivating, motivational activity.

SW #28 - PomPom

An activity that builds hand strength by encouraging the student to move pompoms with a tong from one container to another.













SW #29 - Closure

Students put oversized pompoms into containers before screwing down the cap for closure.

SW #30 - Bead Patterns

Coordinating the use of two hands, the student strings beads on either a pipecleaner or shoelace, following a prescribed pattern.

SW #31 - Stretch

Using two hands, the student stretches colored loops between dowels creating various patterns.

SW #32 - Shape- Up

The student places up to three geometric shapes over the dowel matching the corresponding shape or picture.

SW #33 - Around the Block

Match colors on a six-sided block to a template velcroed to the lid, encouraging fine motor control.

SW #34 - Positive Attraction

The student uses a wand to move magnetic washers through plastic tubes, placing them onto a wooden dowel. The curious behavior of magnets encourages concentration and fine motor control.













SW #35 - Twister

Encourages fine and gross motor development, eye-hand coordination and opportunities to engage the midline by winding a link-chain around dowels in a variety of ways.

SW #36 - Bullseye

The student removes puzzle pieces from the open side and matches them to a jig on top of the lid.

SW #37 - Variations

Challenges rigid behaviors by providing the opportunity to see singular objects in a variety of ways. The student is given three variables for each object.

SW Folder Tasks

This set of (4) folder tasks contains familiar images, numbers, colors and a do-it-yourself for customization. Periodically assess the individual's ability to use them during one-onone sessions. Once mastered, add the folder tasks as part of the independent structured work session.

SW Sound Cylinders

Match five cylinder pairs by sound alone.

SW Mystery Bag

Match eight pairs of different wooden objects by reaching into the bag, without looking, to find the matching object by feel.

#2186 - Pony

#764 - UNO Spin



NW #1 - Blocks with Velcro

Separate clothespins from plastic cards and place into appropriate openings; a self-correcting activity.

NW #12 - Stack It

Stack Blox upon the one that is preset by teacher onto the shoebox lid.





NW #13 - Cups

Stack cups upon one that is preset by teacher onto the shoebox lid.

NW #14 - Beads with Dowel

Take beads from open container and stack onto upright dowel.
